The Village of Wellington established the Senior Transportation and Rides (STAR) program to assist in meeting the transportation needs of our senior population. The goal of STAR is to offer safe, transportation by providing door-to-door service for qualifying seniors. Funding is provided by the Village of Wellington and the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban development.

How It Works:



The Village of Wellington provides a STAR card to each user that can be loaded with up to 8 one-way trips each month. These trips are FREE to the user. Users just swipe the card at the beginning and end of each trip



Passengers are responsible for scheduling and canceling their own trips with Wellington Cab, and should call 24 hours in advance




Riders may take 1 additional passenger without using any additional trips



Transportation is provided to any destination within the following boundaries:

- 1) Anywhere within Wellington
- 2) Along 441 between Southern Boulevard & Lake Worth Road
- 3) Palms West Hospital and its surrounding medical offices



Eligibility:

In order to be considered for the Program, the applicant must:



Be at least 62 years of age



Be a US citizen or legal alien



Reside within Wellington



Provide a copy of valid photo ID for verification
